#### WON'T YOU TAKE A STEP UP?

Every new pledge and every pledge increase allows us to build up this community to make a difference in the world. We ask that you prayerfully consider taking a generous step up in your 2020 pledge.



## NEW TO PLEDGING? **PLEDGE**

Make a pledge. A pledge is a promise to give a specific amount during the year. Pledges assist the Vestry to more accurately estimate the resources that will be available for the ministry of the parish in a giving year. Pledges may be increased or decreased during the course of the year due to changes in circumstances.



## IF YOU DO PLEDGE, **GIVE PROPORTIONALLY**

Strive to be a proportional giver, which means committing to give a percentage of your income back to God. The Biblical standard of giving is 10%. Stewardship is a journey, and it is important to start at a level appropriate to your household.



## IF YOU DO PLEDGE PROPORTIONALLY, **TITHE**

**Become a fifther.** Intentionally increase the proportion of your pledge until you reach the Biblical standard of 10% or beyond. Increase your giving incrementally year-by-year, until you reach the tithe or beyond.
